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Information for Authors

1. Scope of Contributed Papers

The contributed papers of the Journal of the Combustion Society of Japan (JCSJ) are devoted to the advancement of the science and technology of combustion through the dissemination of original archival research papers, review papers, technical reports, brief communications and discussion among readers (Table.1). They shall be written in Japanese or English according to the formatting specifications. The journal is published four times per year, February, May, August and November.

2. Submission of Manuscripts

The corresponding author to submit the contribution for JCSJ shall be a member of the Combustion Society of Japan (CSJ), while this rule does not apply for the submission of papers requested by CSJ or for the corresponding author from a Supporting membership organization. Signed assurance must be given that the manuscript or its equivalent has not been submitted for publication elsewhere.

For review, send three copies of the original manuscript by airmail to the society office (please refer to the back of the journal), or a pdf file of manuscript by E-mail to the following address.

The cover page shall include the complete authors information (affiliation, full postal address and E-mail address). The original manuscript should be prepared in compliance with the most recent regular issues or using a template available from the website of the Combustion Society of Japan (<http://www.combustionsociety.jp>). In case electrically submitted, it shall be specially advised that the pdf file be readable regardless of the machines. The authors are requested to preview the file before submission.

All submitted manuscripts are subject to a review procedure. When revision is requested by the Editorial Board, the authors must send the revised manuscripts along with the answers to the comments from reviewers as soon as possible. No response over half a year may be regarded as the authors' intention of withdrawing their contribution. After the authors are notified of the acceptance of their contribution, the manuscript of their final

version containing figures and tables will be requested to send to the above-mentioned address in one of the following three methods: (a) Send MS-Word files electronically if the file size is less than 3 MB, (b) Send the MS-Word files recorded in a CD-R by mail, (c) Send the clear manuscript and its text file recorded in a floppy disk by mail. Always keep a backup copy of the electronic file for reference and safety. Full responsibility rests with the author.

3. Copyrights

All authors must sign the "Transfer of Copyright" agreement before the article can be published. This transfer agreement enables the article to protect the copyrighted material for the author, but does not relinquish the author's proprietary rights.

4. Publication Charges

The publication charge is free. However, the authors will be charged for color at current printing costs. Offprints can be ordered at current printing costs and a transmittal fee using the order form sent to the author after the manuscript has been accepted.
