Publication Ethics Statement

1 Authors

- 1) Submitted papers must make a novel contribution to the advancement and development of combustion science, technology and engineering.
- 2) Submitted papers must not contain any fabricated, falsified, or inappropriately manipulated data. Plagiarism of data, text, or ideas from previously published papers is prohibited. Submitted papers must be original works.

 Duplicate submission or publication of the content of another paper written in any language is prohibited.
- 3) Authors must provide appropriate citations when using the data or ideas of previous work.
- 4) All authors must make a significant contribution to the scientific content of the manuscript, must share responsibility for the content of the paper, and must agree to the submission and publication of the paper.

2 Editorial Committee

The editorial committee makes decisions on the acceptance or rejection of papers based on the peer-review reports. The committee shall promptly inform authors of the decision.

3 Reviewers

Reviewer shall assess papers fairly and promptly from a professional viewpoint while bearing in mind the responsibility that comes with their role. Reviewers must decline to review a paper when there is a conflict of interest or when it is not professionally appropriate for them to review the paper. Reviewers must keep the content of reviewed papers strictly confidential and must not reveal the content to others.
